This includes the acolytes, the Christian Mothers and the children from the parochial school who helped with the luncheon, the staff of The Backyard, the Floral Bokay, Sherry Stoffel (parish photographer), the Carmelite Nuns and all those who took part in any way to make this day special for Fr. Venner, his family and friends. The day was a great celebration of the gifts of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and the Holy Priesthood. May we see a return to the days when St. Mary's fostered a culture of vocations to the Priesthood and Consecrated Life. Let us pray for Fr. Venner and for vocations!

Saint Mary Parish was founded, under the patronage of Mary, Help of Christians, in the Year of Our Lord 1885. The cornerstone of the second and current church was laid on July 4, 1898, with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass celebrated in it for the first time the following year. It was solemnly Consecrated according to the Roman Pontifical on June 18, 1907 by the 2nd Bishop of Sioux Falls, the Most Reverend Thomas O'Gorman. It was placed on the National Registry of Historic Places in 1985, the Centennial Year of the founding of the parish. On July 4, 2010, the parish celebrated its Quasiquintennial.

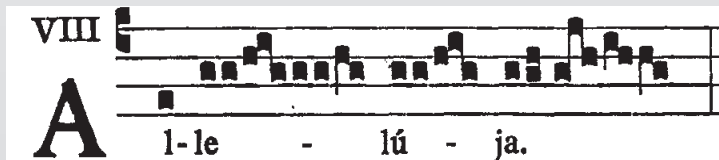
